This letter is a request for the purposes of the FOI Act 1982. It relates to the grant the subject of questioning by Senator Dean Smith and Senator Bragg in Senate Estimates on Tuesday 30 May 2023 (Cyber Wardens).

I seek access to:

- Item 1: The Grant Opportunity Guidelines used to establish the grant.
- Item 2: The grant agreement insofar as the agreement details:
 - a) required outcomes
 - b) The performance information and other data that will be used to evaluate the grant
 - c) The criteria that will be used to evaluate the grant, the grantees compliance and performance
- Item 3: The most recent evaluation report of the success/failures/outcome/results/value for money of the program.

I do NOT seek access to duplicates of any document captured within the scope of the request; I ONLY seek access to final documents, unless a final does not exist, in which case I seek access to the most recent draft.

I do NOT seek access to the phone numbers or full email addresses of government officials, nor the names and contact details of government officials not in the Senior Executive Service or equivalent. I do ask that junior official's position or titles be left unredacted, along with email domains that

provide useful information as to the origin and destination of communication e.g.
'[redacted]@treasury.gov.au'.
